21ST ASIA-PACIFIC CONGRESS ON FAITH, LIFE AND FAMILY (ASPAC) IN BANGKOK, THAILAND



This November Human Life International is sponsoring it premier, biennial event, the 21st Asia-Pacific Congress on Faith, Life and Family (ASPAC) in Bangkok, Thailand. *ASPAC is the largest pro-life gathering of leaders in Asia and Oceania*.

ASPAC provides fertile training ground for pro-life leaders to efficiently and effectively defend Faith, Life and Family in their respective countries. As a forum for regional and global pro-life leaders, the congress allows them to get to know, share, strengthen, and inspire each other as the pro-life movement faces increasing challenges. The 21st ASPAC is being held in coordination with the Episcopal Commission for Social Ministries,



specifically CARITAS Thailand, and the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Thailand, chaired by His Excellency Philip Banchong Chaiyara, C.S.S.R., bishop of Ubon Ratchathani. The venue is the scenic *Baan Phu Waan* (House of the Sower of the Seed), Pastoral Training Centre of the Archdiocese of Bangkok, which was also the site of the 14th ASPAC in 2007.

said: "I have always considered myself pro-life, but only here I understood what it is and how to be pro-life." She went on to declare her city a "Pro-Life City," banning promotion and distribution of contraceptives, despite earning pro-abortion ire.

- There are conversions of heart. A tearful abortionist responded: "It is only now I comprehend what I have been doing for years. I'm so glad I came."
- From someone occupying a sensitive government post: "I always avoided the subject of abortion but these sessions have opened my eyes. Now I've got to convince our government to turn pro-life."
- Some accepting of contraception rethought their positions. One was an ill-catechized priest, who'd also previously thought *in-vitro* fertilization and other reproductive technologies condemned by the Church were still pro-life.

IRA Charitable Rollover

If you are 70½ years old or older, you can make a tax-free gift from your individual retirement account (IRA) directly to our organization.

How It Works

- You must be $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older at the time of your gift.
- You may transfer any amount up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA to Human Life International.
- The transfer is not considered to be taxable income, and therefore does not generate an income tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your tax deductions.
- If you have not yet taken your required minimum distribution for the year, your IRA charitable rollover gift can satisfy all or part of that requirement.

HLI's Miami office, headed by Adolfo Castañeda, spends part of each week spreading this vital Catholic message via Spanish-language media.

MV, a Catholic cable and web-based station, reaches Hispanics all over the United States and Latin America. Cuban-American host Bill Brown requested HLI's Adolfo Castañeda appear on a show called, "Adelante Familias" ("Go Families").

Brown wished to focus the interview on Saint Pope John Paul II's writings on *Theology of the Body (TOB)* – a subject near and dear to Castañeda's heart. Along with HLI volunteer and educational advisor, Felipe Vizcarrondo, MD, MA (Bioethics), Castañeda has been motivated to speak and write on the topic for years."The request helped me confirm God is truly asking me to talk and write more about the teachings of *TOB*." By the grace of God, the María Visión program was a success. Tens of thousands watched and many expressed how it truly helped them see Catholic marriage in a new light.

THEOLOGY OF THE BODY AND HUMANAE VITAE


Theology of the Body reflects HLI's mission: revering the dignity of the human person, honoring the conjugal nature of the body open to life, thereby acting as a prism through which we perceive marriage as the source of Life and Family. As a Sacrament, a visible sign instituted by God to give grace, marriage mirrors the divine love of Christ for His Bride, the Church, in the love between husband and wife.

Theology of the Body's over 100 catecheses are a commentary on Humanae Vitae, the prophetic encyclical that has become a stumbling block for many - sadly, even inside the Church. Fr. Paul Marx, HLI's founder, was one of the most ardent defenders of this historic document condemning contraception.

We would ask that you continue to pray for the mission work of our Spanish-speaking staff, including Adolfo Castañeda. He may be heard weekly on HLI's Radio Program "Defiende la Vida" ("Defend Life") aired on Radio Católica Mundial - World Catholic Radio - and other programs.

MISSIONARY TRIP TO BRAZIL

Human Life International recently conducted a mission trip to Brazil, August 27th to September 3rd. As HLI Delegate for International Missions, I held a series of talks in Brasilia, the country's capital, Goiania, and São Paulo. "The Promoter of Integral Development Association" (PRODEIN), a pro-life, pro-family Catholic non-profit, hosted HLI.

Popes Benedict XVI and Francis have both visited Brazil. Catholic since the 1500s, the nation is the largest Catholic country worldwide. As everywhere though, Life and Family are under attack. Knowing this, Pope Benedict stressed during his 2007 papal trip to Brazil: "Life is beautiful, it is not something dubious but is a gift, and even in difficult conditions, life is always a gift. Therefore, re-create this awareness of the beauty of the gift of life." Yet the Culture of Death is making inroads. Brazil now allows abortion in cases of: rape, danger to the mother's health and anencephaly. Sadly, many are leaving the Church and joining evangelical communities. The Ministry of Education promotes LGBT agenda, even in primary schools. This is why there is a continued need for HLI witnessing to Church teaching on life issues and in defense of the family.

Shortly after arriving, the PRODEIN religious sisters invited me to lunch. Then I started the litany of talks in Brasilia that would continue throughout the entire mission trip. Beginning with around 100 theology students of FATEO Catholic University, I spoke on "Contemporary Challenges for

Human Rights and Pro-Life Action." The focus was moral relativism and the Gospel of Life as expounded by Saint Pope John Paul II. Over the next few days I gave several more addresses:

- "Bioethics and Pro-Life:
 Responsibilities of MedicoTechnological Developments,"
 at Bom Jesus Parish, on life
 issues affecting the medical
 profession, attended by doctors
 and medical students
- "Our Lady in the Defense of the Family against Relativism" at Most Holy Sacrament Church
- The message of "Our Lady of Fatima" at the Catechetical Center of Our Lady of the Encounter with God, before a mixed audience aged 8-80
- "What is Missionary Action?" analyzed from the perspective of the Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (defense of the family)
- "The Role of Students
 Defending the Right to Life"
 at Immaculate Heart of Mary
 Church
- and "Pro-Life Action" at the Encounter with God's Catechetical Center.

Monday meant driving to Goiania, a large center 100 miles away from Brasilia. There Catholic radio, "Luz da Vida" ("Light of Life") interviewed me, The station had also hosted me on air three years earlier. I took this opportunity to mention "100 Years of Fatima", a talk I gave later that evening, at Our Lady Aparecida Parish.

One might ask, on a mission for Life, Love and Family, why preach on Fatima? Because our Blessed Virgin Mother is *always* relevant to Life, Love and Family. As St. Alphonsus Liguori once said, "He can never be lost who recommends himself to thee, my Mother; he alone is lost who does not have recourse to thee."

The next day Fr. Luiz Augusto interviewed me on television and radio, which was followed by two more talks to the Luz da Vida community. Wednesday it was back to Brasilia's church of St. Jude Thaddeus, where I spoke on "The Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart" *(defense of the family)*.

Then, on Thursday, I gave a lecture to 80 seminarians, professors and staff of the Legionaries of Christ at Mater Ecclesia Major Seminary in São Paulo. The Seminary Rector requested two lectures: "What are Good and Evil and Who Decides?" and "The Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus" (*defense of the family*). I repeated the second talk again Sunday for the Legionaries' minor seminary, at the request of Rector, Fr. André Delveaux.

This was a most successful mission trip. I am always delighted to represent HLI's Pro-Life, Pro-Family, Pro-Faith mission through apologetics, Our Lady of Fatima and the Sacred Heart, all of which aid in promoting the Gospel of Life. A big thank you to our donors for your generosity and prayers, and to Our Lady Aparecida, patroness of Brazil, for all her intercession.


