Bertha's school taught contraception, not chastity. She and a boy from her class wandered down the wrong path. **When she told him she was pregnant, he wanted nothing more to do with her.**

When she told her parents, they threw her out and told her not to come back until she got an abortion.

With your support, Fr. Z gave her counseling and found her a place to stay for a while. Then he journeyed to her hometown to have a talk with her parents.



Meanwhile, your missionaries in Africa are responding to a different crisis. You won't see it on the news, but it has the potential to endanger as many lives as the war.


Planned Parenthood Global is trying to push a bill through the East Africa Coalition Parliament. If it passes, it will force seven countries to adopt abortion on demand.

license to kill pre-born children, they were furious. The grassroots opposition convinced most leaders to vote no.

Thanks to you, that bill failed, and the pre-born are still relatively safe in Malawi.

In 2020, it was Kenyan children on the chopping block.

Your investment in pro-life training really paid off that year. Hundreds of Kenyan priests are experts at pro-life work because you sponsored their pro-life training in the seminary.

When Planned Parenthood started pushing for abortion on demand, HLI Kenya raised an army of pro-life priests. They organized their parishes to protest the bill and ask their leaders to vote no.

Because of your investment in the pro-life mission, that bill failed too.

Your missionaries are so effective that anti-lifers often try to bribe or threaten them into quitting. But it never works. You empower them to keep the mission going no matter what obstacles they face.

YOU ARE FUELING A HIGH-IMPACT CAMPAIGN FOR THIS HIGH STAKES BILL

This bill is even more dangerous than others you've blocked in recent years.

It affects a whole region of Africa. And it includes

a sex-ed curriculum that teaches kids that fornication, abortion, and other evils are ok.

If it passes, it will put millions of pre-born children at risk of abortion. And the pro-life culture won't last long with young people learning anti-life values in school.

Thanks to you, the campaign to stop this bill is going full throttle. Your missionaries are using all their tried-and-true methods to lead their countrymen to defend life.

We need your continued support to make all this happen.

Beating an abortion bill in one country takes effort. Organizing a united opposition across seven countries takes a lot more. Your missionaries rely on you for the resources to fuel these plans.

Because the stakes are higher this year, they are taking the campaign up a notch.
